WHO WE ARE



RWANDA INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF OPHTHALMOLOGY (RIIO) REMAINS COMMITTED TO PROVIDE AFFORDABLE AND COMPREHENSIVE SPECIALIZED EYE CARE SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITY AT KIBAGABAGA HOSPITAL AND TO OTHER UNDERSERVED REMOTE AREAS WHERE THERE IS NO OPHTHALMOLOGISTS IN THE SPIRIT OF UHC, LEAVING NO ONE BEHIND DURING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY -JUNE 2022 RIIO IN COLLABORATION WITH DIFFERENT PARTNERS PERFORMED DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES AS HIGHLIGHTED IN BELOW:

RIIO-KIBAGABAGA COMMUNITY EYE CLINIC PERFORMANCE

During the mentioned period clinical activities have continued at RIIO@KIBAGABAGA Clinic. Patients were seen and get treated those who received surgical interventions restored their sight. Due to the high demand as well as improving access to high quality eye care services, the Ministry of Health has upgraded the Eye Clinic department at Kibagabaga to become a referral facility. There have been over four thousand patients seen with hundreds receiving surgical interventions.



II. COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

Cataract Outreach Program

RIIO is part of the National Eye Health Outreach program and supports 6 District Hospitals in Eastern, Northern and Western Provinces where there are no Ophthalmologists, it is in this framework that RIIO Directors conducted cataract surgeries in different hospitals.

World Glaucoma Week 2022

We organized a free Glaucoma screening session on 11th March 2022 (at the RIIO@Kibagabaga Community Eye Clinic. Members of the public aged 40+ were screened and tested for Glaucoma by RIIO Medical and Admin staff team to mark #worldglaucomaweek, as the result 184 patients were seen among them 3 confirmed cases of Glaucoma identified and advised.



ACHIEVEMENTS

Supporting Academic and Professional excellence

KISII EYE HOSPITAL ACCREDITED AS RIIO TRAINING SITE

In order to continue supporting the Academic and Professional Excellence of our Residents, RIIO has an agreement with different training institutions across the world among them KISII Eye Hospital in KENYA as one of the RIIO Training sites, for the period of 4 months starting from December 2021-March 2022. 4 PGYI Residents have greatly benefited from clinical knowledge under the supervision of Professor PAUL KIAGE. All have expressed their gratitude to RIIO Management as well as KISII Management for the opportunity given to them.

He will provide skill transfer and training for the program's ophthalmology residents and coordinate and supervise visiting global ophthalmology fellows.. In addition, he will assist in RIIO's community outreach and development programs to bring eye care to rural areas in Rwanda.
