RIIO-KIBAGABAGA COMMUNITY EYE CLINIC PERFORMANCE

During the reported period, clinical activities have continued at RIIO@KIBAGABAGA Clinic. Patients were seen and get treated those who received surgical interventions restored their sight. Over 3500 patients received treatment.

CATARACT OUTREACH PROGRAM

In order to contribute towards ending avoidable blindness in Rwanda by serving the community RIIO Directors accompanied by Residents have conducted cataract outreach campaigns in remote areas where there are no Ophthalmologists. Over 100 surgeries were performed at 5 different hospitals.



ACHIEVEMENTS

ROLL OUT OF DR SCREENING AT RWANDA DIABETES ASSOCIATION CLINIC USING AI

Rwanda International Institute of Ophthalmology (RIIO) in partnership with Orbis International has provided skills and primary resources in order to allow Rwanda Diabetic Association, to integrate diabetic retinopathy (DR) Screening on a regular basis at the clinic and therefore meet the demand of the Diabetic patients. This continuous activity will build on the positive impact noted in the RAIDERS study conducted by RIIO. RDA Staff who will use the machine and screen patients have been trained by Professor Ciku on how to screen and use the AI machine, RIIO staff who will coordinate and supervise the implementation of this activity participated in the training.

RECOGNITION

In September 2022, Our RIIO Directors were awarded a certificate of appreciation in recognition of RIIO Contribution towards ending avoidable blindness in Rwanda, the event was hosted by FHF Jointly with the MOH.


